ICE Raids Are Wrong: Document Safely, Protest Peacefully

We condemn the use of federal power to terrorize immigrant communities. These actions are rooted in systemic injustice and must be met with organized, peaceful resistance.

Record safely if you witness an ICE encounter.

Do not share unverified raid locations—confirm before posting.

Blur faces and license plates before sharing video on social media.

Protest is a powerful tool—use it peacefully.

Avoid provocation and remain calm.

Make space for those most directly impacted to lead and be heard.
